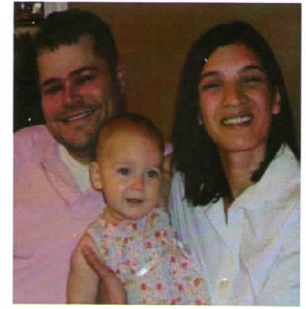
Tactical Operations Rover
